

The Admissions Process of Shanti Business School, Ahmedabad starts in April beginning of every year, in line with the policy guidelines receive from AICTE from time to time.

SBS, Ahmedabad has AICTE approved programs with the intake details as below:

- 1. PGDM (General) 180
- 2. PGDM (Marketing) 60
- 3. Vocational Program (BFSI) 30

The Director SBS, Ahmedabad has constituted an Admissions Committee consisting of the Director, Executive Registrar and the faculty panelists. Prior to the Admissions process begins, the Admissions Committee meets and review the Admissions policy followed in the previous year and based on the suggestions finalize the policy changes if any.

The Admissions Committee recommends the policy guidelines to the Board of Governors. On the approval of the Board, the guidelines will be published in the form of an Admissions brochure and communicate the same to the stake holders and the prospective students.

Who is eligible for PGDM?

The PGDM programs are open to graduates of any University recognized by the UGC.

The graduation should conform the (10+2+3) years or (10+2+4) years of schooling.

The candidates must have completed graduation with minimum 50% of aggregates marks and 45% in case of specified categories. Those in the final year of graduation may seek provisional admissions.

Provisional admissions will be granted subject to the students submitting the graduation results satisfying the above conditions latest by 15th October of the year of admission.

The candidates must also have valid scors from any of the all India tests: CAT/MAT/XAT/ATMA/CMAT taken not earlier than 12 months at the time of application.

Who is eligible for Vocational Program (BFSI)?

Candidate shall have passed the qualifying examination of Standard XII - 10+2 pattern from any stream (Commerce, Arts, Science, Vocation and Home Science) and ITI or Diploma equivalent from any board (CBSE/GSHSEB/ICSE/NIOS).

A candidate who has passed the Qualifying Examination after appearing in the supplementary examination conducted by the Board shall be eligible for admission in the current academic year on the Vacant Seats.

Students who have qualified 12th standard exams prior to current academic year are also eligible with other conditions remaining same.

Admissions will be done on the merit basis based on the result of Standard 12th (HSC) or Equivalent Diploma.
